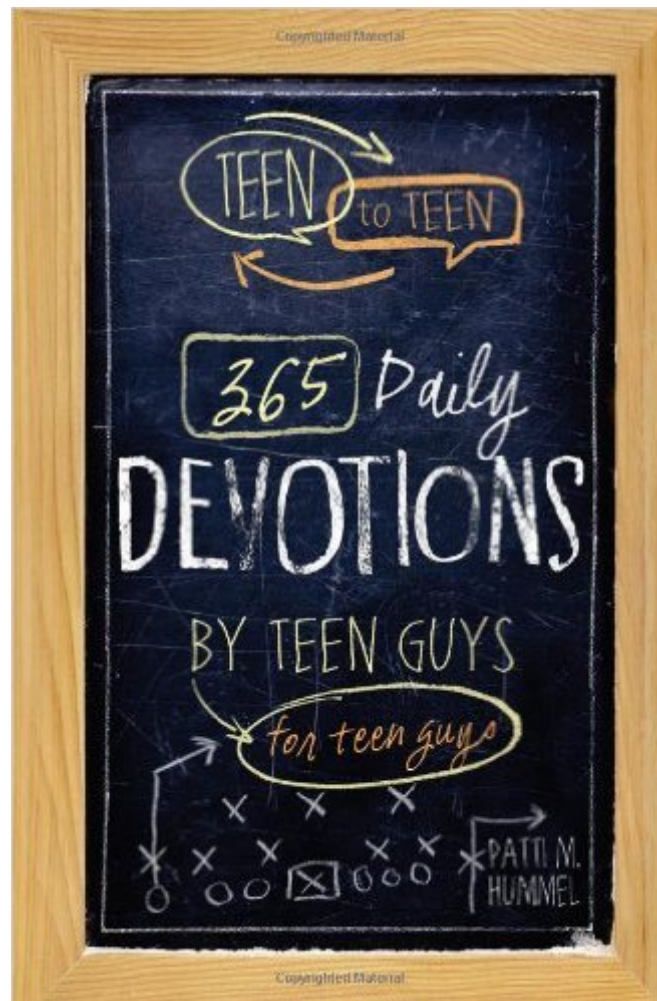

I bought this book as a way to get my 14 year old son reading the word daily. We joyfully (YES, he likes it!) take turns reading it out loud just before dinner. It gives us a positive conversation starter for the meal and has even encouraged him to share some problems he or his friends are having in school. The only thing I don't really like about it (thus the 4 star rating) is that it is a rare translation

(I'd never heard of it) of the Holy Bible - Holman Christian Standard Bible. We (almost daily) pull out our NIV or The Message to compare wording. The messages are written by teen boys (13-19) who appear to have a strong Christian upbringing and write of good values and thoughts to contemplate. We are fairly new to christianity - only 5 years - so it's refreshing to see a different thought process than that of the world from a young adults point of view.

I got this devotions book for Christmas this year and so far I'm loving it. It is written by teens and that makes it really easy to relate to and it is reads so smooth and easy to understand and read id say it would good for for ages around 11 to 17 overall I sink it is o worth it for the price I highly recommend you get it.

Almost every single daily Devotion was from a boy in a Baptist school. Not real life people! How about other denominations or Christian kids in public schools?
