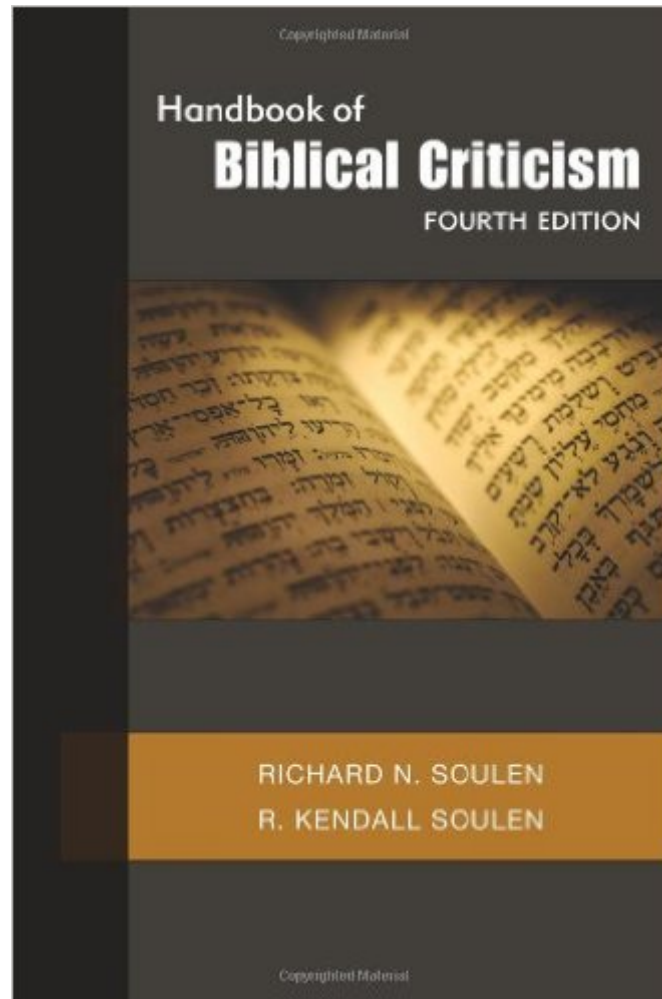

This is an encyclopedic reference book for students of Biblical studies, providing definitions and discussions of many of the terms you may hear or read. Here are some examples of topics, chosen at random: Eisegesis, The Gospel of Thomas, The Jesus Seminar, The New Hermeneutic, The Synoptic Problem. You get the idea. The book is quite exhaustive now that it's reached its fourth edition, and I use it for occasional reference, but I do once in a while feel frustrated by the emphasis of precision in definitions over simple explanations, particularly when the discussion is not accompanied by examples. In other words, it could sometimes be more user-friendly. Never-the-less, there is a lot of good information, presented quite compactly.

I purchased the 4th edition expecting a 272 page volume as listed on the product information page. The actual volume contains only 258 pages. Note that the 2nd edition contained 239 pages while the 3rd edition contained 234 pages. So an expectation of receiving a volume (4th) with a 16% increase in number of pages (page-wise v the 3rd) was not realized. And this was part of the reason that I purchased the new edition of the book.
