

It was there again the next day after I was leaving Bible Study. Not knowing who it belonged to and intrigued by the title I took it home to read. I thought at first that it was just a book on Genesis, which to a certain extent it was, but it was more than that. It was more like a journey of the author which she was sharing with her readers.
