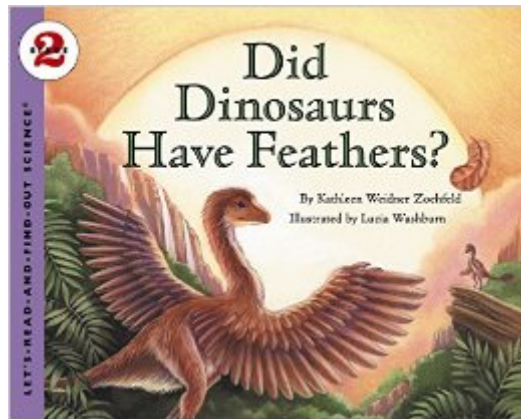

This display, like the book, focuses on fossils found in an area of China which show the outlines and textures of feathers.
